The conference will delve into the academic discourse on climate justice, critically examining how linear, biophysical approaches and conventional narratives of climate change have evolved into apolitical doctrines that dominate contemporary discussions. By foregrounding questions of power, inequality, and ecological responsibility, it aims to rethink and expand these dominant frameworks.

Climate change is reshaping ecosystems, livelihoods, and human-environment relations, yet its impacts are unevenly distributed. The lens of climate justice emphasizes how these transformations intersect with structures of power, privilege, and exclusion. 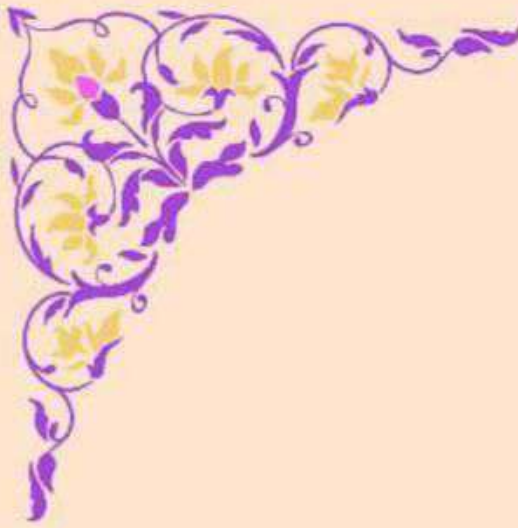
